

An Acrostic Poem by JoDana





made of God-Substance.





Presence





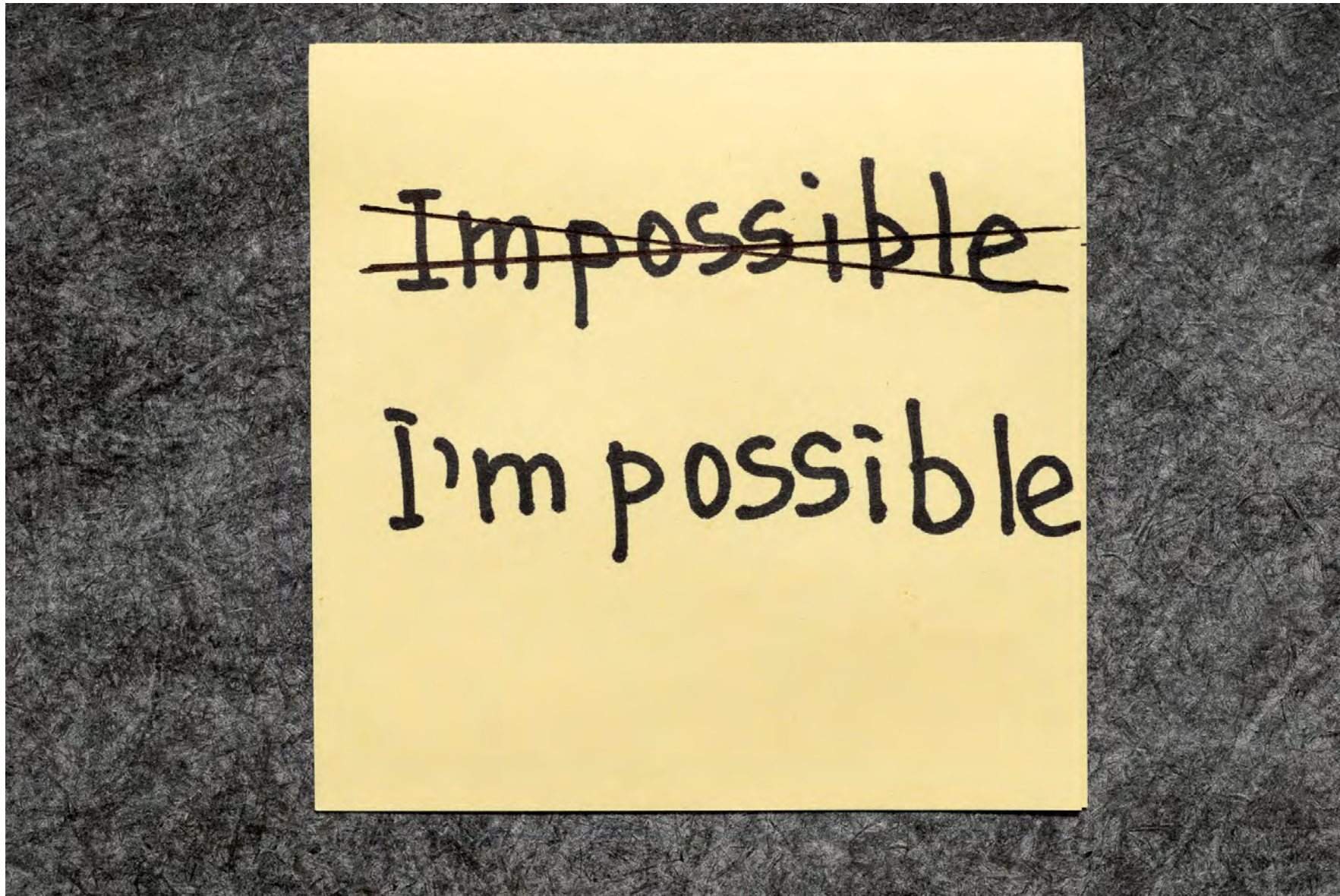
Every day, you and I must remember

ocean. Substance is everywhere.






R is for

wants to give you everything.






T is for

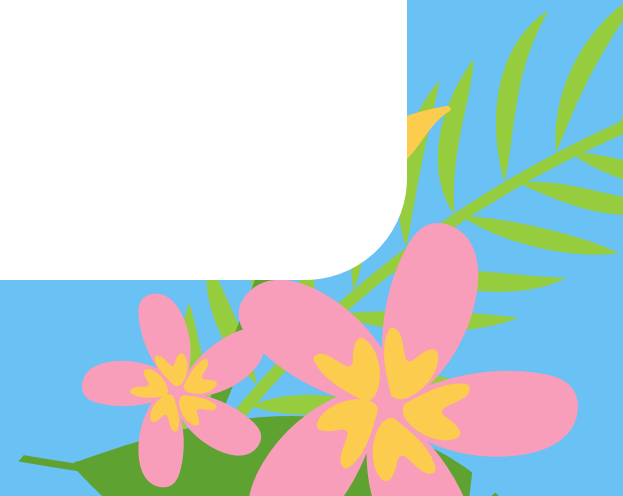







U is for the Unity Principle

Even Right Here! Right Now!






**L is for limitless
